No Soliciting

You asked, and we listened! The HOA receives many complaints and concerns about unauthorized Door to Door Sales. It is a Safety and Privacy issue for many. **No Soliciting** signs have been installed at each entrance, therefore No Soliciting is permitted in the community. Free window clings are also available in the lobby of the NAPD station on Village Blvd.

Please note that any Solicitor must have and show proof upon request, of a permit granted by the City. If you have a concern, please call the non-emergency line at the New Albany Police Dept and provide them with a description and location of the Solicitor so they can check for a valid permit.



- Yard signs are not permitted in New Albany Links. Please see <u>NALHOA.com</u> for the very few specific exceptions.
- Holiday lights and decorations are permitted within 30 days of the holiday. This is your friendly reminder that it is now time to take down those Christmas lights.
- ALL Exterior Modifications must be preapproved by the HOA. Please allow plenty of time to submit your request and plans for review before scheduling any work with a contractor. See <u>NALHOA.com</u> for more information.

It will soon be time to vote for your favorite HOA Board Members! All Future information for the candidates and voting will be on the association website **www.nalhoa.com**.


